Conflict minerals (Dodd-Frank Act)

In August 2012, the U.S. States Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC) passed the definite specifications on the topic of conflict minerals as described in section 1502 of the Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act (Dodd-Frank Act).

Conflict minerals are tin, gold, tantalum and tungsten, the primary products of which are mined in the Democratic Republic of the Congo and its adjacent countries. The mining of such primary products in the regions concerned partly contributes to the violation of human rights and the financing of violent conflicts in this region.

Section 1502 of the Dodd-Frank Act and the implementation provisions of the SEC require enterprises under SEC supervision to provide a report concerning the conflict materials contained in the products they manufacture or commission. The objective is to end the violation of human rights in the regions concerned.

Camille Bauer Metrawatt AG, being a supplier of high-quality industrial instrumentation is not subject to SEC supervision. However, we are aware of our social responsibility and acknowledge that the SEC provisions require our direct and indirect customers to report on conflict minerals. Camille Bauer Metrawatt AG supports its customers reasonably in their obligation to report.

Since 2014, Camille Bauer Metrawatt AG endeavours not to buy any material containing conflict minerals, if possible. We will improve our processes reasonably in order to know and reduce the use of conflict minerals.
